PLEASE USE NARROW-TOPPED VASES

- 1 3 different spring flowers - 1 bloom of each variety
- 2 3 yellow **OR** 3 white daffodil blooms - large trumpet*, one variety
- 3 3 narcissi blooms - medium cup, one variety
- 4 3 narcissi blooms - small cup, one variety
- 5 7 tall daffodil/narcissi blooms - mixed
- 6 5 dwarf multi-headed narcissi - mixed
- 7 3 tulip blooms - same or mixed
- 8 3 hyacinth blooms - same or mixed
- 9 3 blooms from bulbs other than above classes - one variety

* trumpet as long or longer than petals

- 10 3 stems hybrid hellebores - same or mixed
- 11 1 stem of a flowering shrub - max width 15 inches (38cm)
- 12 Flowering pot plant - max 10 inch (25cm) pot diameter
- 13 Foliage pot plant - max 10 inch (25cm) pot diameter
- 14 3 stems of polyanthus
- 15 3 pansies - mixed
