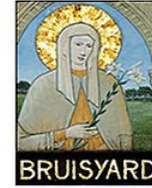
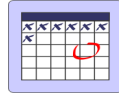

Rural Wellbeing Survey – come and give your valuable input to this research. Kerry from Community Action Suffolk will be at the Bruisyard village hall on Wednesday February 5th 1-3pm.

Community Action Suffolk, on behalf of East Suffolk Council, are now conducting a deeper exploration of all previously reported challenges and barriers, as well as finding out more about possible solutions. We want to learn more about what they are and how they affect people living locally, together with gathering their ideas and suggested solutions that could help improve things for everyone. We are speaking directly with local organisations, groups and residents, both through this survey and in-person. We will be providing a full report to East Suffolk Council, presenting our findings on a **village-by-village** basis so that they can have better understanding about health and wellbeing needs and provisions in the area, and hear how they can work with you to improve things. This is why it is imperative that your village is represented in this work.
